The Feldberg (at 4800ft) is home to one of the largest ski resorts outside the Alps. Skiing, snow boarding, snow walking and sledging are all popular sports here.

There are numerous ski runs for all abilities in the area and ski schools and equipment hire are very competitively priced.



A 30 min bus ride from outside the house brings you to the Feldberg ski resort and all of our guests receive a free bus pass.
