Winter sport in the Black Forest

Haus Barnabas in the village of Utzenfeld, lies about 1800 ft above sea level and for those interested in winter sports, a free bus service from outside our door brings you in 30 minutes to the Feldberg ski resort which, at its highest, is more than 4800 ft. With 38 ski lifts almost on our doorstep there are numerous opportunities for all degrees of skill and in addition to its range of downhill pistes our area offers additional opportunities for cross-country skiing. Lift prices are very competitive and equipment can be hired for single days or longer.



Utzenfeld lies just 3 miles beyond the little town of Todtnau marked top centre on the above diagram of Feldberg ski lifts.

Holidays for winter sport are possible in Haus Barnabas throughout the whole winter. Most years there is snow on the Feldberg between end of December and Easter.

Winter holidays also for non-skiers

Every season in the Black Forest has its particular attraction and winter is no exception. It is a very rare day when public transport is not running on time, as even on snowy days, snow ploughs and blowers keep roads open on all routes.

Guests marvel at the **beauty of sunshine on snow covered hills and trees** as warm buses and trains carry them safely to places like Titisee, where sometimes the lake itself is frozen over, or Freiburg or other towns where inviting cafés serve hot chocolate and apple strudel or other delicacies.

Warm thermal baths are another option and to lie immersed in warm water with steam rising in the cold outside air is an experience not to be missed.

Walking. Specific tracks of machine compacted snow across hills and through forest enable walking enthusiasts to enjoy the winter scenery with ease. For the more adventuresome, the hire of special snow shoes to fit over your own footwear enable walking over unprepared snow!
